TERMS AND CONDITIONS

If you're planning to apply for a scholarship, you will need to submit an application for scholarship, an essay along with a resume, and college transcript.

The application process

1. Complete and submit the scholarship application
Prof. Emmanuel Kolawole Scholarship awards scholarships to students who have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement and also have financial need. **Application must be written in person**
2. Provide your government issued ID and previous academic qualifications.
3. Submit an offer of admission letter from Biblical University or ACHETS Missionary University.
4. Recommendation letters are also required from a pastor or ministry leader of each applicant.
5. Write and submit an essay along with a resume
6. Attempt an interview
7. Recipients are selected based on a variety of factors, including financial need.

The essay

Write a 7 to 10 page essay where you describe

- * your faith journey
- * your sense of calling from God concerning further biblical study and/or ministry
- * the strengths and gifts you would bring to the church through further biblical study and/or ministry
- * how your gifts for ministry have been affirmed by others
- * the strengths and gifts you would bring as a spiritual leader at Biblical University or ACHETS Missionary University
